Post pandemic challenges have resulted in bigger gaps between access to affordable high quality vet care & the barriers pet owners face. Despite our own struggles with staffing and having to replace old equipment, 2022 saw Beesley Animal Foundation continuing to support pet families in need and finding ways to reach these pets through our programs of affordable spay/neuter and preventative vet care including financial assistance, education, and through our Community Outreach program which provides vaccinations and dog/cat food to those underserved including senior citizens and those facing homelessness.
